Sealed bids will be received by the Town of Franklin, WV, for a tank rehabilitation and repainting project until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time on June 22nd, 2017, at The Town of Franklin, 305 North High Street Franklin, WV 26807, at which time bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. The project will be bid in one contract.

(1) 400,000 Gallon Morton Lane Water Storage Tank Rehabilitation and Repainting: Construction time limit is (90) calendar days with liquidated damages of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) per day. This project consists of sand blasting, re-painting and various rehabilitation items on the existing 400,000 gallon water storage tank. Alternate #1 which will include removing (1) existing 400,000 gallon water storage tank and the replacement with a 438,000 gallon tank which includes: site work, grading, E&S Controls, foundation, fencing, gates, fittings, and all other necessary appurtenances required to complete the water storage tank installations and removal

A two-envelope system will be used. Each Bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope. Envelope No. 1 must contain the Receipt of Addenda, Bid Bond, Power of Attorney, EEO Certification of Compliance, and all other necessary documents as required on the Bid Opening Checklist. Envelope No. 2 must be a separate sealed envelope marked "Bid Proposal" and must contain the completed and signed "Bid Proposal Form". Both envelopes must have the following information in the lower left hand corner.

Name and address of Bidder, Bidder's WV Contractor's License Number, "Bid on Morton Lane Water Storage Tanks Rehabilitation Project, "Contract # and Title", for the Town of Franklin, 305 North High Street, Franklin, WV 26807. To Be Opened at 2:00 p.m., Thursday, June 22, 2017.

The main envelope, "Envelope No. 1", will be opened first and the Receipt of Addenda, Bid Bond, Power of Attorney, EEO Certification of Compliance and all other necessary and required documents as listed on the Bid Opening Checklist, will be checked to ensure that all documents are in order. If the documents are found to be in order, then "Envelope No. 2" containing the "Bid Proposal Form" will be opened and publicly read aloud. If the documents are not in order, the envelope containing the "Bid Proposal Form" will not be opened and the Bid will be considered non-responsive and returned to the Bidder.

No Bidder may withdraw their bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the time of the opening of the Bids.

Any Contractor submitting a Bid on this project hereby certifies, indicates and acknowledges that he/she has a license and meets all the qualifications required by the statutes of the State and subdivision in which the work is to be performed.

The Town of Franklin reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities.
