

**TARIFF FORM NO. 12
PUBLIC NOTICE OF
CHANGE IN RATES BY MUNICIPALITIES**

NOTICE is hereby given that the **Town of Franklin** has adopted by Ordinance, on June 13, 2018, an increase in its rates, tolls and charges for furnishing water service to 691 customers at Franklin and vicinity, Pendleton County, West Virginia.

The proposed increased rates and charges will become effective **8/6/2018**, unless otherwise ordered by the Public Service Commission, and will produce approximately **\$75,939** annually in additional revenue, an increase of **21.7%**. The average monthly bill for various classes of customers will be changed as follows:

The increases shown are based on average usage of all customers in the indicated class. Individual customers may receive increases that are greater or less than average. Furthermore, the requested rates and charges are only a proposal and are subject to change (increases or decreases) by the Public Service Commission in its review of this filing. The Commission shall review and approve or modify the increased rates only upon the filing of a petition within (30) days of the adoption of the ordinance changing said rates or charges, by any customer aggrieved by the changed rates or charges who presents to the Commission a petition signed by not less than twenty-five percent of the customers served by such municipally operated public utility.
