**NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO CHANGE RATES**

PEER'S SANITATION, LLC  
CASE NOS. 19-1084-MC-19A and 19-1085-MC-19A

On November 4, 2019, Peer's Sanitation, LLC, filed with the Public Service Commission of West Virginia requesting increased rates and charges for the transportation of trash, rubbish and garbage for its customers.

The Staff of the Public Service Commission has reviewed the application and recommended increasing the commercial and residential rates as follows:

<u>RATES (MONTHLY)</u>	<u>PRESENT</u>	<u>STAFF RECOMMENDED</u>
Residential	\$16.25	\$18.50
Commercial	Negotiable	(13.85% increase)

The Commission will adopt rates and charges for the Applicant which are greater than, the same as, or less than the Staff-recommended rates and charges.

Anyone desiring to protest the proposed changes must do so, in writing within ten days of the date of publication of this notice. All protests should be addressed to the Executive Secretary, Public Service Commission of West Virginia, P. O. Box 812, Charleston, West Virginia 25323. To help the Commission determine the justification for additional review and investigation, protests should be specific as to reasons that the changed rates and charges should be modified. In addition, anyone desiring a hearing in this matter must demand a hearing in the letter of protest. If no substantial protest is filed, the Staff-recommended rates may be approved without hearing. The application and Staff recommendations are also available online. Customers may also file a comment electronically at the Commission website.
