Dkt. No. 44. On March 9, 2018, DETI posted the required bond and deposited with the Clerk a certified check in the requisite amount. Dkt. No. 46 and 47. On January 10, 2020, the Court granted DETI's Motion for Summary Judgment, ordering that DETI remit to the Clerk of the Court the amount of \$519.28, plus pre- and post judgment interest, to be paid to the remaining defendants in compensation for the easements conveyed to DETI through this condemnation proceeding. Based on the cash deposit already in the registry of the Clerk in this matter, the Court FINDS that security is no longer necessary "to pay the costs and damages sustained by any party found to have been wrongfully enjoined or restrained." Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(c). Furthermore, the Court FINDS that, as of April 30, 2020, the amount of \$543.95 would be the amount

of just compensation plus pre- and post judgment interest owed to the remaining defendants.

Accordingly, for good cause shown, the Court GRANTS the Plaintiff's Motion Regarding Payment of Just Compensation, Release of Excess Cash Deposit, and Return of Surety Bond. The Court ORDERS the Clerk to release and deliver to DETI the surety bond in this case. 


