Each sealed bid must be typed or written in ink and on a blank sheet of paper. Each Bid shall have written on the front of the envelope "Sealed Bid for Surplus Items". Sealed bids must contain the name, address, daytime telephone number of the Bidder, and a self-addressed stamped envelope in order to be considered. Each bid price must clearly refer to the Item Number and Item Description as listed herein. Bidder must submit one bid page for each item being bid. After consideration of all sealed bids received, each sale will be made to the highest acceptable bidder. Successful Bidder will be notified by telephone directly following the opening and evaluation of bids. Any Successful Bidder, who is unavailable via telephone, will be notified by certified mail, and will be required to contact the City Clerk, during regular business hours, by the end of the next business day directly following receipt of Certified Notice, and make arrangements for the final sale of item(s) involved by the end of the following business day.
