NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO CHANGE RATES (Tariff Rule 19-A)

On March 9, 2020, Clover Public Service District filed with the Public Service Commission of West Virginia an Application requesting increased rates and charges for furnishing water service to approximately 387 customers in Roane County, West Virginia.

The Staff of the Public Service Commission have reviewed the Application and recommended increased rates and charges designed to produce approximately \$32,177 annually in additional revenue, an overall increase of 15.45%. The prior and Staff-recommended rates are as follows:
