NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO CHANGE WATER RATES

On March 9, 2020, Clover Public Service District filed with the Public Service  
Commission of West Virginia an Application requesting increased rates and  
charges for furnishing water service to approximately 387 customers in Roane  
County, West Virginia.

The Staff of the Public Service Commission have reviewed the Application  
and recommended increased rates and charges designed to produce approxi-  
mately \$32,177 annually in additional revenue, an overall increase of 15.45%.  
The prior and Staff-recommended rates are as follows:

Anyone desiring to protest the proposed rates and charges must do so, in  
writing, within ten (10) days of the date of publication of this notice. All pro-  
tests should be addressed to the Executive Secretary, Public Service Commis-  
sion of West Virginia, P. O. Box 812, Charleston, West Virginia 25323. To help  
the Commission determine the justification for additional review and inves-  
tigation, protests must be specific as to reasons that the proposed rates and  
charges should be modified.

The Commission may adopt rates and charges which are the same as, great-  
er than or less than the Staff-recommended rates and charges.
