Additional assessments due to new construction or improvements to existing real property, including beginning recovery of natural resources, and newly acquired personal property shall not be included in determining whether to reduce excess levy rates or in calculating the new levy rates for any such fiscal year.</p> <p>The Board of Education of the County of Morgan will not issue bonds in conjunction with approval of this levy.
